## Cedarville High School CCP Course Information

- Enroll, one time only, as a High School CCP student at <a href="https://www.clarkstate.edu/admissions/admissions-for-college-credit-plus/students/">https://www.clarkstate.edu/admissions/admissions-for-college-credit-plus/students/</a>
- Students who have not yet taken a course must attend a CCP orientation.

- Once enrolled, students must meet the required Accuplacer or ACT scores in the chart below.
  - If students have an A in 9th grade English, they are considered "remediation-free" in Reading and can enroll in ENG-1111 or the like (PSY-1111/HST). Anything lower than an A and they must take Accuplacer.
  - If students have a B in Algebra II, they are permitted to go into MTH-1060 Business Math or STT-2640 Elementary Statistics (bypass the QRAS placement test & go right into AAF test).
  - If students want to take MTH-1280 College Algebra, MTH 1340 PreCalc or MTH 2200 Calc and do not have appropriate college-level course pre-req or applicable scores, they will need to take Accuplacer QRAS/AAF or AAF. If students earned a C or better in MTH 1340, they do not need to take the Accuplacer to enroll in MTH 2200.
  - Students taking QRAS and AAF, must receive a 260 on QRAS before they are permitted to take the AAF portion.
  - College Ready Scores Accuplacer: 250 in Reading OR QRAS of 263 OR AAF of 263
  - College Ready Scores ACT: English 18 <u>OR</u> Reading 22 <u>OR</u> Math 22
  - Students must also have a cumulative unweighted GPA of 3.0 or higher to enroll in these classes or if they have a cumulative unweighted high school GPA of at least 2.75 but less than 3.0 and received an "A" or "B" grade in a relevant high school course.

- If you wish to retake the Accuplacer you must wait 7 days. After the second retake you must wait 30 days and 120 days after the 3rd retake. It is \$15 for each subject test if you wish to retake the test. The first one is no charge.

  accounts, go to Virtual Bookstore under the Quicklinks tab and check the box for the CCP voucher.
  DO NOT ENTER YOUR CREDIT CARD INFO. You will NOT be able to rent your books. Book
  Vouchers are available 7 days before the semester starts.
