



HCRP Region 15 Homeless Crisis Response Program COVID-19/TANF RRH & HP

IHN has been working diligently to access funds to help support individuals and families during these challenging times that may end up facing homelessness or are currently facing homelessness due to COVID-19.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The HCRP Homeless Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program will provide financial assistance and services to prevent individuals and families from becoming homeless and help those who are experiencing homelessness to be quickly re-housed and stabilized. The funds under this program are intended to target individuals and families who would be homeless but for this assistance. The goal of the HCRP program is to promote housing stability. Every household assisted by the program is provided case management to help them identify needs, establish a safe living situation, and to create a plan that connects them to the resources needed to help them obtain and maintain housing.

Eligible Clients

To be eligible for assistance with TANF HP/RRH funds, households must meet the following eligibility criteria:

- Be homeless or at-risk of homelessness
 - Homeless - either living in an emergency shelter, in a hotel paid for by a charitable or public organization, or in a place not meant for human habitation OR
 - At-risk of homelessness – household will imminently lose their primary nighttime residence with in 14 days AND has no subsequent residence identified AND has no resources or support networks to identify alternative housing
- Have custody of at least one minor child
 - Further prioritization for households with a child under age 3
- Be eligible for TANF assistance in Ohio
 - Must be a household with custody of at least one minor child
 - Total household income cannot exceed 200% of the federal poverty level
