

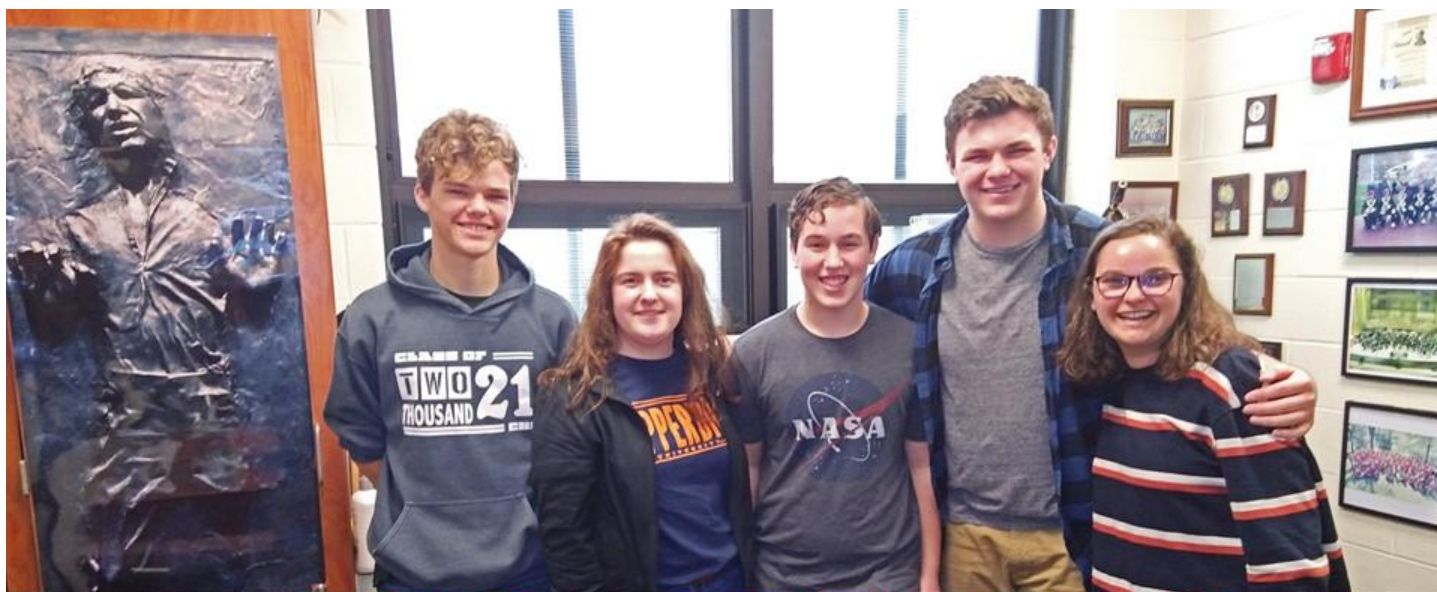
Cedarville Music Boosters News to use June 2019

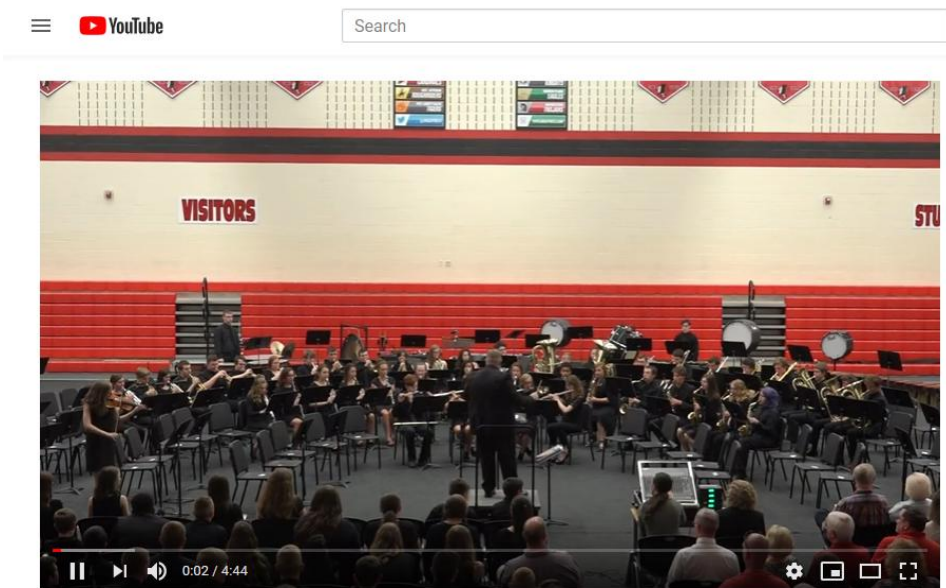


May wrapped up the concert season with 3-shows. All were received well and the crowds loved them. Here are some highlights...

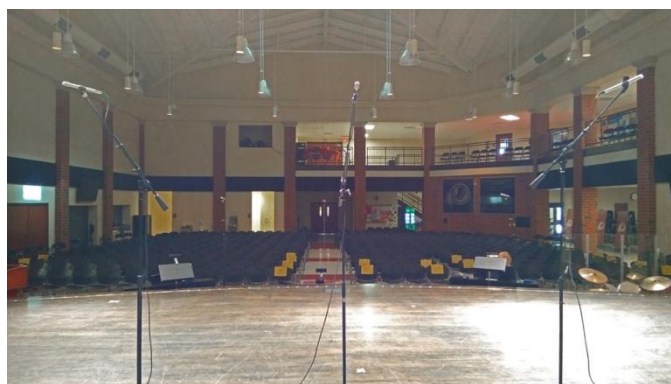
