Said Matt Sheridan, Board President at Cedar Cliff, “Our search began in July and culminated in our selection of Mr. Masser as our next Superintendent. He comes highly regarded by everyone we spoke to, and his knowledge and experience are what set him apart from the candidates we interviewed.”

A seasoned teacher and educational leader, Mr. Masser has 12 years of experience in school administration. In addition to his current role as assistant superintendent for Clark-Shawnee Local, he served assistant principal at Northeastern High School for two years and high school principal at Greeneview for five years. Before securing his first administrative positions, Mr. Masser was an English teacher for Kenton Ridge High School.

Mr. Masser has a bachelor’s degree in Integrated Language Arts Education from Cedarville University. He also holds a master’s degree in Educational Administration, from the University of Dayton. Mr. Masser has also presented at events for Cedarville University.

In Mr. Masser’s words, “I am honored to accept the superintendent torch after 10 + years of faithful stewardship by Mr. Chad Masson and 20 years from his predecessor, Dr. David Baits. Cedar Cliff has enjoyed incredible stability at the superintendent position, and I look forward to continuing this tradition.
