Summer Free Lunch Program

As a leading nonprofit for strengthening community through youth development, healthy living and social responsibility, the YMCA is addressing child hunger in communities this summer. Partnering with the Walmart Foundation to increase participation in the U.S.

Department of Agriculture (USDA)'s Summer Food Service Program (SFSP), provides free meals to children aged 18 and under while school is out.

The Xenia YMCA's Summer Food Program will begin Monday, June 7th and continue through August 9th. This program is open to any child age 18 and under. No proof of income required. Lunch will be served at Shawnee Park, Monday through Thursday from noon until 12:30. On Friday, there will be activities for children and free books will be provided to students who are in attendance.
