We play in a league out of Clark County and this will involve some travel. Up to half of the games will be played at the Cedarville Community Park. **There WILL be a limit to team size and as such, we highly recommend not waiting until the last minute to sign-up. The regular season will start at the end of April and will end in the middle of June. Tournament play starts after regular season with the championship games the weekend after July 4th.**

MINOR WAIVER/RELEASE
RELEASE OF LIABILITY FOR MINOR PARTICIPANTS

Read before signing:

In consideration of (player name) _____, my child/ward, being allowed to participate in any way in the Cedarville Softball and Baseball Association, related events and activities, the undersigned acknowledges, appreciates, and agrees that:

1. The risk of injury to my child/ward from the activities involved in these programs is significant, including the potential for permanent disability and death, and while particular rules, equipment, and personal discipline may reduce this risk, the risk of serious injury does exist; and,
2. I for myself, spouse, and child/ward, I knowingly and freely assume all such risks, both known and unknown, even if arising from the negligence of the Cedarville Softball and Baseball Association or others, and assume full responsibility for my child/ward participation; and,
3. I willingly agree to comply with the program's stated and customary terms and conditions for participation. If I observe any unusual significant concern in my child/ward readiness for participation and/or in the program itself, I will remove my child/ward from the participation and bring such attention to the nearest official immediately; and,
4. I, for myself, my spouse, my child/ward, and on behalf of my/our heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, hereby release and hold harmless Cedarville Softball and Baseball Association, its directors, officers, officials, agents, employees, volunteers, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, and advertisers, and if applicable owners and leasers of premises used to conduct the event, with respect to any and all injury, disability, death or loss damage to person or property incident to my child/ward involvement or participation in these programs, whether arising from the negligence of the Cedarville Softball and Baseball Association or otherwise, to the fullest extent permitted by law.
